



Dear Parent and/or Guardian:

We are very happy to welcome your camper to a wonderful experience of camping, a ministry of Montlure Presbyterian Church Camp. Even though we are still displaced due to the Wallow Fire, Montlure is excited to offer five weeks of camp at the Pine Canyon Camp in Willcox, AZ, at the foot of the Chiricahua Mountains. To help offset the increased costs of renting another site, this year three fee options for each camp are presented on a tiered basis: Tier 1 represents the historically heavily subsidized rate, Tier 2 a partially subsidized rate, and Tier 3 provides the option to pay the actual cost of camp for those who can afford to do so. This is a voluntary tiered-payment program and in no way influences the experience children receive. It provides the opportunity for families to take an active role in supporting the true cost of their child's camp experience.

Serving as the Montlure Camping Council, we are committed to providing a Christ-centered camp of exceptional quality for all campers and, as an American Camp Association Accredited camp, Montlure is operated in accordance with the highest national standards for safety and supervision of children and youth in a camping environment. Please complete all sections of the following registration form for your camper either by typing or by printing clearly in dark ink. (Please note that on-line registration will soon be available on our website, www.montlure.org.) All registration forms will be treated in confidence and will only be seen by appropriate members of the Montlure staff and Council, and the director of the camp your child will be attending.

All registration forms must be signed on page 2 by a parent/guardian and by the camper.

Registration for your camper will be confirmed when the application is complete and all fees are paid in full. A confirmation notice will be sent from the Montlure Registrar via email or mail. About two weeks before camp, the camper will receive a registration packet in the mail providing final details for camp. This packet includes the Montlure Bus Passport which requires parents/guardians to complete emergency contact and medical information, and a medical release form. Once completed, this document serves as the camper's bus pass.

Transportation

Travel for campers is provided to and from camp by chauffeured bus, with adult chaperones providing supervision. The bus route begins in Phoenix, will make a stop in Casa Grande, and a final stop in Tucson. All campers are strongly encouraged to ride the bus. If the bus locations are not near your area and you would be interested in carpooling with others, select the bus location closest to you or “Your own transportation” if the camp is more convenient, AND initial the “Interested in a carpool” box or boxes. This gives permission for the registrar to share your interest with others from your area who also grant this permission.
