**Cancellation Policy:** Cancellations less than two weeks before camp starts will result in forfeiture of all camp fees. For cancellations more than two weeks before camp, fees paid will be refunded less a \$50 handling charge per registration.

**Financial Assistance** is available to enable campers to come to camp who may otherwise be unable due to financial circumstances. Initially, please contact your Pastor as the Presbyteries and many churches have funds designated to support such situations. If necessary, your Pastor should contact the Montlure Council in strict confidence.

## **Advance Medical Information**

A formal medical release will be included as part of the Camper Passport you will receive about two weeks before camp. At this time, is there anything else we should know about your child as we plan for camp? For example, has this camper ever been diagnosed with ADHD, Learning disabilities, Depression, Mental Illness, Bi-polar Disease, Eating Disorders, Asthma, Epilepsy, Diabetes, and/or Any Operations or Serious Illness or Injury. Your frankness about any physical or emotional health issues will help the camp staff plan more effectively for your child's experience at camp.

## **Agreements and Signatures**

	I will notify the camp if my child is exposed to any communicable disease (for example: strep throat or mononucleosis) during the three-week period prior to attending camp.
	I give permission for photographs including my child to be used in camp publicity.

In case of any medical emergencies, I understand that every effort will be made to contact the emergency contacts I will identify on the Camper Passport. In the event the emergency contacts cannot be reached, I hereby give permission to the physician selected by the camp to hospitalize and secure proper treatment for my child, including administering anesthesia or surgery.

## **Bring-a-Buddy Program**

The Montlure Camping Council wishes to continue to expand the Montlure camping experience to those who have not previously been to Montlure. We recognize that the best recommendation for new campers comes from those who have already been to a camp at Montlure and choose to return. Thus we are repeating our **Bring-a-Buddy** (BaB) program this year which will result in Camp Store credit of \$20 to a returning camper for each new camper they introduce to Montlure. The BaB program works as follows:

- \* The *Returning Camper* must name the *New Camper* below *or* the *New Camper* must name the *Returning Camper* below.
- \* The *New Camper* registration form must be received by the Registrar no later than 30 days after the *Returning Camper's* form.
- \* The BaB Program ends on April 30, 2008. All registration forms along with all camp fees must be received by the Registrar prior to April 30 to be eligible for a Camp Store credit.
- \* The maximum Camp Store credit for any one *Returning Camper* under the BaB program will be \$40.
- \* The *New Camper(s)* and the *Returning Camper* do not need to register for the same camp.
- \* Only *New Campers* entering Grade 6 or higher are eligible for Camp Store credit to the *Returning Camper*.
- \* The decision of the Montlure Camping Council will be final on all aspects of the BaB program.
