## Bus Information Letter 2010

Dear Montlure Camper:

We are sending you some important information for transportation to and from Montlure Camp this summer so that the trip is fun and safe for everyone. Even if you have been to camp before, this information may have changed, so it is important that you and your parent(s) and/or guardian(s) read this information.

### **BUS PASSPORT** (Bright colored sheet of paper.)

- This must be filled in completely and signed by the parent and/or guardian. It must accompany the camper on **Saturday** morning (**Senior High** and **Junior High** camps) or **Friday** (**Juniors** camps) in order to be allowed on the bus. (No other papers are necessary to board the bus.) Be sure to check that you have your **BUS PASSPORT** with you before leaving home!
- **NO CAMPER WILL BE ALLOWED TO BOARD THE BUS WITHOUT A MONTLURE PASSPORT.**
- Camper will be signed in by the Dispatcher when the camper is ready to take his/her place on the bus. Camper must not get off the bus after being signed in. Upon return at the end of the week, the camper will be signed out by whoever picks him/her up.
- All medications, including over-the-counter items, must be in a closed plastic bag with instruction form included, and camper's name clearly written on the outside of the bag. You will give these to the Dispatcher when you board the bus and the Chaperone will turn them over to the medical person upon arrival at camp.

### **Some hints for a comfortable trip...**

- There may not be a bathroom break on the way to camp. The bus will be equipped with a bathroom should you need it.
- Bring a water bottle with your name on it. No other beverages will be allowed on the bus.
- Bring a sack lunch which you may want to save for late morning. No food will be served at camp until dinner in the evening. (Please no M&Ms, raisins, nuts, or other loose foods which can make for a messy bus.) No extra food please, because due to animal "invasions" of cabins **NO FOOD IS ALLOWED IN CABINS.**

Your chaperone is a volunteer who wants each camper to have a good camping experience, which begins and ends with the bus ride each way. You can count on the chaperone to help with any needs you may have.

### **BUS PASSPORT** (Bright colored sheet of paper)

- This must be filled in completely on and signed by the parent and/or guardian. It must accompany the camper on **Saturday** morning (**Senior High** and **Junior High** camps) or **Friday** (**Juniors** camps) in order to be allowed on the bus. (No other papers are necessary to board the bus.) Be sure to check that you have your **BUS PASSPORT** with you before leaving home!
- **NO CAMPER WILL BE ALLOWED TO BOARD THE BUS WITHOUT A MONTLURE PASSPORT**
- Camper will be signed in by the Dispatcher when the camper is ready to take his/her place on the bus. Camper must not get off the bus after being signed in. Upon return at the end of the week, the camper will be signed out by whoever picks him/her up.
- All medications, including over-the-counter items, must be in a closed plastic bag with instructions included, and campers name clearly written on the outside of bag. You will give these to the Dispatcher when you board the bus and the Chaperone will turn them over to the medical person upon arrival at camp.

### **Some hints for a comfortable trip .....**

- There may not be a bathroom break on the way to camp. The bus will be equipped with a bathroom should you need it.
